All of our prayers and thoughts are with the Royal Family at this difficult time.



Andrew, Anthony and Rodney were deeply saddened to hear the news of the death of Queen Elizabeth II. As Sovereign, Monarch and Head of State of the Commonwealth, the news has put the World in a period of grief and sorrow. To many of



us, all we have known is The Queen as leading light of Monarchy. That light has sadly gone out, but the legacy will last forever. Whilst we mourn, and over time, we should remember wonderful life of our Queen, which as a community we celebrated only 3 months ago with her 70 years on the Throne. May she now rest in eternal peace.

Only a few day's before, we were extremely sad to hear of the sudden passing of ClIr Angela Newton. Angela served as District Councillor for almost 50 years, along with serving on Lincolnshire County Council twice over a 21 year period, and being many committees such as the South Holland Voluntary Car Scheme - an organisation which offers transport to many residents in our Ward. It was truly right and correct the Angela received an MBE in 2021 for her services and dedication to the local community. There is no doubt that Angela passing will leave a huge hole in the local area and we offer our sincere condolences to Angela's family. Lastly, visitors will be able to buy a wide selection of delicious food, crafts and gifts from various special stalls, alongside our fantastic usual Saturday market traders.
