As many of you will know, consultations have recent been taking place by energy companies attempting to ruin our views over open skies and take prime agricultural land which feeds the nation. Andrew, Anthony and Thomas are strongly opposed to proposals for a solar farm almost 2500 acres in size (that's over 100 times larger than Moulton Park) and the 50m pylons required to connect to another proposal of a supersized connection station in Weston Marsh. We are also opposed to the National Grid proposal running from Grimsby to Walpole, which will bring more 50m pylons. There are a number of reasons to object, with food security being another key point. These applications are so big, they will almost bypass SHDC as the local planning authority (SHDC will only be a consultee), and be determined by the Secretary of State. We urge everyone to object to these plans, as it is a collective fight from the general public, Parish, District and County Councils through to MP. Additionally, we would suggest people subscribe to Facebook pages for the local Meridian Action Group (MAG) and No Pylons Lincolnshire, both of which are full of information, which is continually being updated.

# Tomato Chutney

August and September are the months where tomatoes seem to ripen far quicker than they can be harvested and used. If you are lucky enough to have a few productive vines – or a friend that is looking to offload some of their surplus tomatoes – this is a great recipe to help use a few up.

***Delicious with a nice strong cheddar!***

## Method

1. Preheat oven to 160oC
2. Wash and dry an empty glass jar and its lid in warm soapy water before rinsing with clean tap water – instead of drying them, place them upside down in the oven and leave whilst you make the chutney.
3. Put all of the ingredients into a heavy based pan and stir well to combine. Place on the hob and heat until simmering.
4. Simmer for 30 – 40 minutes, stirring occasionally with a wooden spoon, until thick and jam like in consistency.
5. Carefully remove the sterilised jar from the oven and pour the chutney into it – screw on the lid tightly.
6. When cool – pop the chutney into the fridge and use within 6 weeks.



## Ingredients

- 125gms red onions – peeled and finely sliced
- 250gms ripe tomatoes – roughly chopped
- 1 small red chilli – deseeded and finely sliced
- 35mls red wine vinegar
- 70gms brown sugar

*Hi everyone,*

*First the good news, it is hoped that the automatic gates and CCTV will be in place by the end of August after which the first phase of new play equipment will begin to be installed at Weston Park. It has been agreed that the automatic gates will have a time sensor whereby the gates will open at 7am until 7pm each day and vehicles in the park after 7pm will be able to exit by driving towards the gates, there will also be a number of warning signs to assist motorists.*

*Weston Hills Park should also see the installation of further new play equipment in the very near future. The council also has plans, to be decided on, to remove if necessary some vegetation in Weston Park to allow the CCTV to have full coverage of the play area and the beacon area where picnic tables will be installed. There are on going discussions to possibly move the skate park to a location so that it can be covered by the CCTV as it's that area we have experienced most of our anti social behaviour.*

*The Council is now up to full strength by the co-option of Anthony Casson, who may be well known to many residents as he was previously on this Council for many years and as Chair for most of those years and we look forward to his involvement due his position on the district Council.*

*At Weston Hills park there is now a small area of garden which was requested by the children at Weston Hills primary school who will attend to its needs on a regular basis.*

*Lastly, and it may not be locals but if you are motorists can I ask that wherever you are driving especially in the Parish that you stick to the speed limits especially with the school holidays having started. Having checked with LRSP, Weston Parish is in the top 3 in the whole County for motorists who have received three warning letters for them being caught exceeding the speed limits by our Community Speed Watch teams.*

## UPDATE ON WORKS FOR NEXT 2 MONTHS:

### Weston Playing Field

- New automatic gates will be fitted - these will be open from **7am—7pm daily**.
- CCTV will be fitted In September with coverage to the play areas, gates and car park.
- Following installation of the CCTV we will be starting the install of new and replacement equipment. There is a significant amount of groundwork required to level the site which will see new swings, climbing frame and springers together with a basketball hoop and new zip wire for the more adventurous. This forms Phase 1 of the works with more works to follow in Spring 2025.
- The skate ramp will be inspected by a specialist equipment provider and we will update via the Love Weston page or in the next edition of the Oracle.

### Weston Hills Park

- Weston Hills Park will be closed to the public from Mon 5th August reopening on Monday 12th August.
- This is due to ongoing works in the Park which will see the installation of a slide, climbing frame, parallel bars, springers and trampoline.
- Any delays in the works will be notified through the Love Weston page and with notices on the Park Gates.
