South Holland District Council



Consultation on how the shape of waste collections in South Holland has now closed with over 8500 residents responding to they survey which was issued due to a mandatory weekly food waste collection set to be imposed from central Government in 2026. Andrew, Anthony and Thomas should like to thanks all residents who responded in the Ward. The next step will start to pull together an analysis of the findings, which will be set against factors required to help make a decision regarding the future for waste collection in District, including environmental performance, financial considerations etc. Once complete this feedback will be presented to Cabinet. Another consultation is underway until 8th October regarding proposed Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO) on dog controls in the District. The proposed PSPO, is being suggested to ensure that public spaces within South Holland are cleaner, healthier and safer places to play, walk, work and visit. Whilst the majority of dog owners act responsibly and pick up any fouling by their pet in a public space, there still are some who let their dogs defecate and leave on the pavement.

The three areas for dog controls proposed under the draft order are:

- A provision requiring the person in charge of a dog to clean up after it, if it defecates in a public space.
- A provision requiring the person in charge of a dog in a public space to have an appropriate means (i.e. a dog poo bag) to pick up any faeces deposited by that dog and to show they have a bag(s) if requested to do so by an authorised officer.
- 3. The introduction of dog exclusion from enclosed children's play areas.

Over recent weeks, there sadly appears to have been an increase in Grafitti appearing within our District and another instance where the monitory spoil the area for the majority. To look to combat this, SHDC and Lincolnshire Police have teamed up by announcing that they will offer a reward of £500 for information which leads to the successful prosecution of the culprit responsible. This financial incentive aim's to encourage residents to come forward and help narrow down the search for the individuals responsible spoiling the appearance of our area. 



















Boris Johnson has always been larger than life. Controversial, untrammelled by the normal rules of politics, his route to becoming Britain's prime minister included a landmark career as a journalist, two terms as London's mayor, leading the Vote Leave Brexit campaign and acting as foreign secretary. He won the largest Tory majority since 1987 when he went to the polls in December 2019 for a mandate to 'Get Brexit Done' - only to have his administration hit by the global Covid pandemic and toppled in a Tory putsch. Cointreau Christmas Cake

Method

- 1. Put the fruit, orange juice and zest, Cointreau and vanilla into a large non-metallic bowl. Mix, then cover with clingfilm and leave to soak for at least 24hr or for up to two days. 2. Preheat the oven to 150°C (130°C fan) Gas Mark 2. Grease and line the base and sides of a 20.5cm (8in) deep round cake tin with baking parchment.
- 3. Put butter and sugar into a large mixing bowl and beat with a handheld electric whisk for 2-3min until light and creamy. Gradually whisk in the beaten eggs, adding a little of the flour if the mixture starts to curdle. Fold in the remaining flour, cocoa, cinnamon, cloves and mixed spice
- 4. Tip the soaked fruit mixture into the bowl and mix well, then spoon into the prepared tin and level the surface (there's no need to make a dip in the mixture).
- 5. Bake for 1hr 40min or until a skewer inserted into the centre comes out clean. Leave to cool completely in the tin, then remove from tin (keeping it in its parchment paper) and wrap in a double thickness of foil. Store in a cool, dark place for up to 3 months



Stir-Up Sunday, which always falls on the last Sunday before Advent, is traditionally a day for making Christmas pudding and Christmas cake so that it still has a full five weeks to mature before the big day. This year, Stir Up Sunday falls on 26th November..... so grab your baking gear and give our recipe a try!

Ingredients

- 300 g each of raisins and sultanas
- 100 g dried apricots, finely chopped
- 100 g dried figs, finely chopped
- Juice and finely grated zest of 2 oranges
- 100ml Cointreau
- 1 Tbsp. vanilla extract
- 175 g unsalted butter, softened, plus extra to grease
- 175g dark brown sugar
- 3 medium eggs, lightly beaten
- 125 g plain flour
- 2 Tbsp. cocoa powder
- 1 Tbsp. ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp ground cloves
 - 2 tsp. mixed spice




