# South Holland District Council



The fight against pylons, and further down the line, the proposed Weston Marsh Sub-Station(s) were debated at May's Planning Committee, with the message to officers to reply to the Secretary of State that Councillors were not happy with proposals and gave strong reasons why. As Andrew, Anthony and Thomas all sit on the Committee, local opinion was given, that whilst the application just appeared to replace existing pylons, the reasoning that the requirement to do so, which was solely to link into the Sub-Station was not acceptable and amongst a variety of reasons, prematurity was a strong case to be put forward as the application for the Sub-Station to date has not been received. The fight continues! Garden Waste Collection Service is now open to all South Holland households. This popular service is available again to the whole District following a redesign of the service. Subscriptions run for a 12 month period with collections every two weeks, making 24 collections for the year. No collections will be made over the Christmas and New Year period. You can apply to join the service at <https://www.sholland.gov.uk/gardenwaste>, or contact one of your Ward Councillors. Once the application has been made to join the service, you will be provided with a collection start day and date. Your collection will be on that day every two weeks and your garden waste collection will be added to your waste and recycling collection information which can be found at <https://www.sholland.gov.uk/mycollections>. Following a series of Democracy Sessions for the young, SHDC has officially launched its new Student Council, a dedicated forum designed to ensure young people aged 11–18 have a meaningful voice in local democracy. The initiative has been created to listen to and better understand the views, concerns and ideas of young residents across the district, while encouraging early engagement with local government. By involving young people at an early stage, the Council aims to help them feel informed, confident and actively involved in decisions that affect their communities. The Student Council will represent young people from schools and youth groups across South Holland, providing a platform for youth voice within SHDC and partner organisations. Members will promote active citizenship, develop leadership skills and gain a greater understanding of how democracy works in practice. As part of their role, Student Councillors will share feedback, ideas and priorities raised by students and youth groups, attend selected council meetings in a non-voting capacity, and hold a seat on the Spalding Town Board to ensure youth perspectives are included in important local discussions. Members of the Student Council have been elected for a one-year term, with re-elections planned for September. We look forward to working with them.

# Key Lime Pie

## Method

1. Mix the crushed digestive biscuits with the melted butter in a bowl - when fully combined, transfer the mixture to 23cm (9in) round, fluted, loose-bottomed tart tin. Press the crumbs into the base and up the sides of the tin to make a biscuit crust and then chill for ten minutes whilst you make the filling.

2. Whisk the condensed milk and cream together until combined, then add the lime juice and the majority of the zest (it will thicken!). Pour onto your biscuit crust and chill for at least 1-2 hours.

3. Remove the pie from the tin and place on a serving plate. As the perfect finishing touch, decorate with the whipped cream and the rest of lime zest and serve.

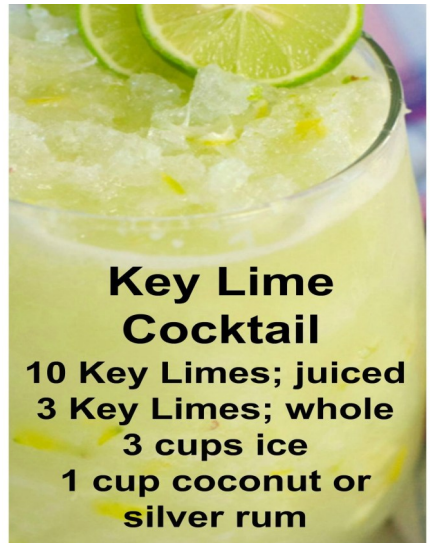


*Not only is Key Lime Pie a delicious addition to any American Independence Day Celebrations but it is also a reasonably quick and easy dessert for a barbecue (assuming the weather is kind to us).*

*It's name comes from the variety of limes that are grown in the Florida Keys and were the inspiration for this dessert but the ones we get in UK supermarkets or farmers markets work just fine.*

## Ingredients

- 250g digestive biscuits – crushed into fine crumbs
- 85g butter - melted
- 400g condensed milk
- 5 large limes - juiced and zest finely grated
- 300ml double cream
- 100mls double or whipping cream – whipped to soft peaks



## Key Lime Cocktail

**10 Key Limes; juiced**  
**3 Key Limes; whole**  
**3 cups ice**  
**1 cup coconut or silver rum**

# Cowbit Parish Council

**A1073**—Parish Councillors met with representatives of Lincolnshire County Council and Highways in early April to receive an update on the old 1073 to Crowland that closed during the summer of 2025. The road has deteriorated to such an extent that in some areas there are fissures up to a metre deep and it's in a very dangerous condition. Extensive surveys have now been completed and Highways presented us with 4 options, ranging from permanent closure to a complete rebuild of the affected sections. A meeting is scheduled for September, following further consultations, when a decision will be taken on the road's future. Cowbit Parish council has made it very clear that permanent closure is NOT an option. Whatever is decided, nothing will happen until at least the financial year commencing April 2027 as the cost will run into millions of pounds and there is no provision in this year's budget. Cowbit Parish Council will be kept in the loop and any further information will be relayed to villagers as and when received.



***A review of the playing field pavilion has taken place, and in order to comply with accessibility regulations, a disability ramp will need to be installed. We are currently seeking quotes in order to apply for grant funding, as this will be a permanent fixture as opposed to a portable one.***

On the 8th of May 2026 the modern ,new village sign was erected, replacing the historic wooden symbol of past years. The old sign has been taken down to be preserved and displayed somewhere in the village. Sadly, it was beyond repair and could not be left up through fear of it disintegrating and falling apart, as the wood had completely rotted underneath the paint. This new sign was designed by a local artist who put their artistic talents to work to come up with this magnificent design which has captured both the past and the present. We will be adding some colour to the sign, as we realise that it's not so clearly visible especially with the Church behind it. We look forward to seeing it installed once it's been painted. We hope you enjoy this new symbol of our village and we pray that it lasts just as long, if not longer, than its predecessor.



We are looking for another member to join our team on the Parish Council. We are a very welcoming council and our focus is to make Cowbit a lovely place to live. If you share that desire and have a couple of hours to spare, then please contact us to find out more. All are welcome to apply, provided you are over 18, have lived or worked in the village for at least a year, are registered to vote and have no criminal record. We understand that a lot of younger people have work and/or family commitments, but our meetings are kept to a minimum, (bi-monthly), and are usually held on a Monday evening.

***Our Parish Council meetings are usually held at 7:30pm in the village hall, and are accessible to all. There's an open public forum for 15 minutes before our meeting commences, so please come along, ask questions, share your ideas and what you'd like us to focus on. 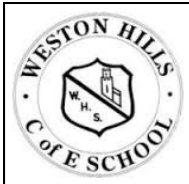

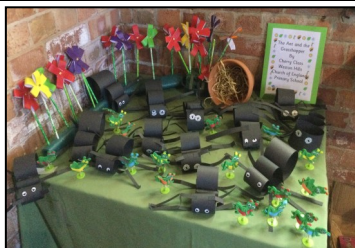

We began the summer term with a welcome invitation to join in with the decoration of our local village church,

St John's, for their flower festival. In keeping with the theme of this year's festival 'Aesop's Fables', the children in our Cherry Class (Reception year group) recreated the fable of The Ant and the Grasshopper which was proudly displayed in the church for visitors to see.



This term, as always, there has been a lot of interactive learning. In Holly Class the topic has been 'All about Carnival', comparing our local Spalding Flower Parade to the Rio de Janeiro Carnival. The children have been reading parade stories, writing their own parade stories and making costumes. They have found out all about Rio and compared it with Spalding and enjoyed learning how to play Samba.



In science, the children have been studying plants, investigating how they grow best. They have been looking at seeds and bulbs as well as comparing the best conditions for plant growth. In computing, they have been learning to use the proper Scratch programme after practising their skills on Scratch Junior.



We are now at the time of year when children throughout the school are formally assessed nationwide. We are extremely proud of the way our Year 6 children have approached their SATs recently. 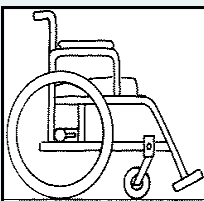

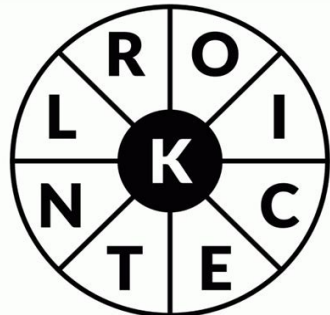
