# South Holland District Council



As previously reported, significant changes to waste and recycling services are being introduced across SHDC, over the coming months as part of the Waste Transformation Programme. This is one of the largest service changes the council has delivered in recent years and will affect all households across the District. As we move closer to implementation, residents will begin to see more information about the changes and what they mean, but a few key points are:

## **What is changing?**

- Distribution of new food waste caddies to households across the District, and a set of new wheeled bins to South Holland as we move away from the weekly sack collections
- Introduction of weekly food waste collections to all areas.
- Changes to waste and recycling collection arrangements.
- New collection calendars and service information being issued to residents across the District
- Updated guidance on what can and cannot be recycled.

**Key Dates:** Bin and caddy delivery begins from **August** Bin and caddy collections begin **w/c 9 November**. Further information for each can be found on the council's website

Local organisations have benefitted from the last round of the UKSPF Grant Scheme, after almost £60,000 was distributed across the District. Local organisations which were awarded the grants, mainly through match-funding are:

Moulton Chapel Community Centre – Purchase of play equipment.

Moulton Park Committee – Car parking improvements including accessible pathways to the play area. Cowbit Parish Council – Renovations to an accessible toilet and accessibility improvements to pavilion. Congratulations to all who were successful and we look forward to seeing the improvements were the money was allocated towards.

At May's Full Council meeting, there were 2 special awards to Cllr Bryan Alcock (Crowland & Deeping St Nicholas) and Cllr Chris Brewis (Sutton Bridge) for reaching an incredible 50 years as SHDC Councillors, and their devotion to public service. Even if younger, Andrew (23 years), Anthony (19 years) and Thomas (2 years) would be very old and most likely still many years away from achieving the length of service Bryan and Chris have at SHDC, but offer their huge congratulation on this achievement.

# Blue Cheese, Ham & Egg Toastie



## Method

1. Spread the butter over one side of each slice of bread, then put the slices on a chopping board, butter-side down. Divide the ham between two of the slices, then spread the chutney over the ham and top with the cheese. Sandwich with the other two bread slices, buttered-sides out.

2. One at a time, fry the sandwiches in a pan over a medium heat for 3-4 mins until golden and crisp, then turn and repeat, pressing down firmly using a spatula or fish slice until the cheese has melted.

3. Heat a drizzle of oil in a second frying pan over a medium heat and fry the eggs until crisp around the edges. Cut the sandwiches in half and serve with the fried eggs on top and a gherkin each on

**Eric Fragale MBE**, has stepped up to take over as Chairman of the Parish Council. Many of you will know Eric through his work in



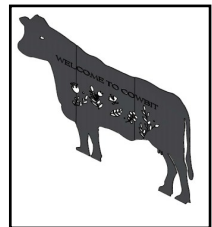

The parish council now has a dedicated Facebook Page. We hope this will help keep residents up to date with local issues. Our newest councillor, **Sam Cooke**, has been working with Jake and volunteers to ensure the safety of the playground so that the children can enjoy it in this lovely weather. They have overseen the work on the drain covers and have made the wet pour surface of the play area safe. It's great to see that the recently acquired goal posts are in place and are being used daily. **Plans for the new play equipment are currently being drawn up.** Five companies have been invited to view the field and submit their designs. Once they have been received, two designs will be eliminated and the remaining three will be displayed in the Hall for the public to choose their favourite. The viewings will be scheduled for one weekday evening and a Saturday morning. For those who are unable to attend the hall viewings, there will be a QR code to scan and these will be available via our website and Facebook page. Watch this space! Following the installation of the new village sign, we have taken note of the comments received from residents, and have taken it down to be 'tweaked' then painted. We hope you will grow to love the new sign as much as the old one, which will be saved and displayed somewhere in the village. Work is progressing on the cows which will be

appearing at the entrance to the village, either side of Stonegate from the A16 roundabout. We have permission from Highways to install them and we're awaiting details of installation via Cllr Condell's Volunteer Scheme. However, as it is not a straightforward job, there will be a cost involved so we are currently awaiting a quote from them. We hope they will become a landmark and help put our village back on the map. They certainly won't be easy to miss!



We are looking for another member to join our team on the Parish Council. We are a very welcoming

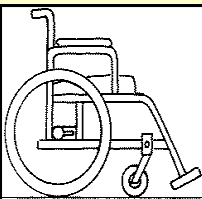

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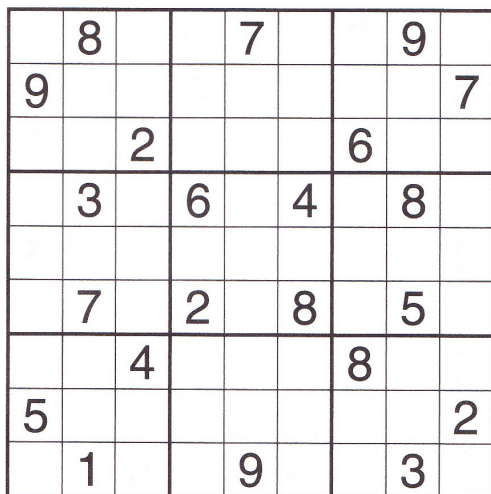

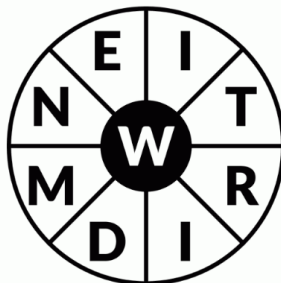
